Why we need this role

What this role involves

You do not need to be available every Wednesday, as there is a rota system in place - you are welcome to do as many or as few walks a month as you can. Ideally, you will be able to commit to at least one walk month.

We are seeking a friendly, enthusiastic person who is able to communicate well with all members of the public.
